Connecting to the U "y ‡ 7 wireless network requires:

- A. A connection to the wireless network SSID (identifier for a wireless LAN) from your device.
- B. Network account authentication to the wireless network.

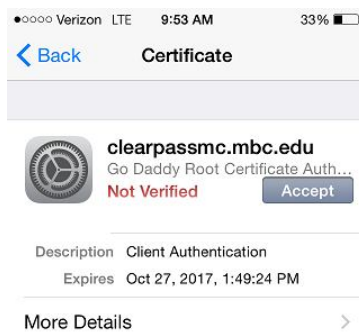
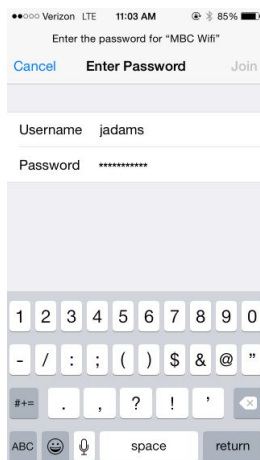

- 1) To connect an Apple iPhone to the U "y ‡ wireless network, find and open the icon  on your Apple device. Tap on Wi-Fi from the main settings page.
- 2) A screen of all available wireless network connections will display that your smartphone can communicate with. Select the U "# ‡ network.



- 3) You will be prompted to enter a username and password. Enter your MBU network username and password to authenticate to the MBU network. Press **K** in upper right hand corner when complete. You will be presented with a # . Select ° .



- 4) After you accept the certificate your network account will be checked for authentication, permissions, and set active. You are now authenticated on Mary Baldwin University's wireless network with access to the internet and some campus resources. **NOTE: Currently smartphones have limited ability to interact with campus resources other than web pages.**
