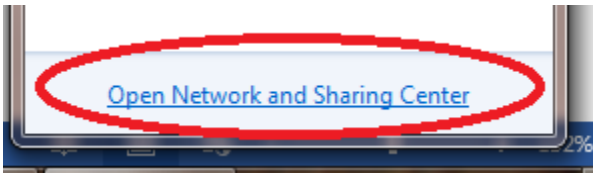


**I have a private personal computer and it can't see MBC Wifi. How can I connect to that network?**

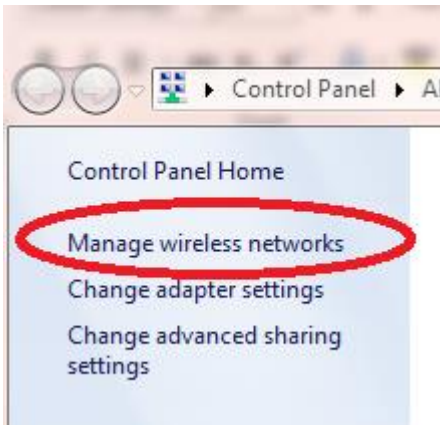
Right click on the Network Connections Icon at the bottom right of the task bar



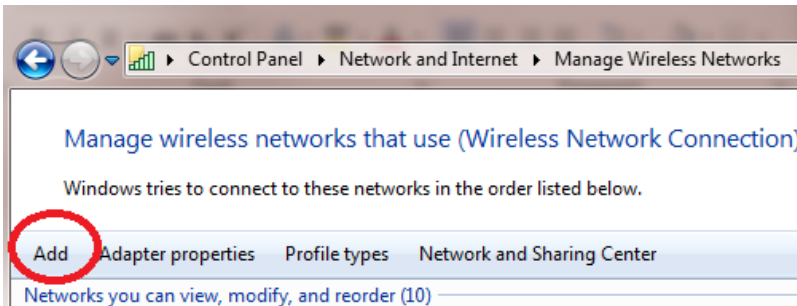
Click on Open Network and Sharing Center



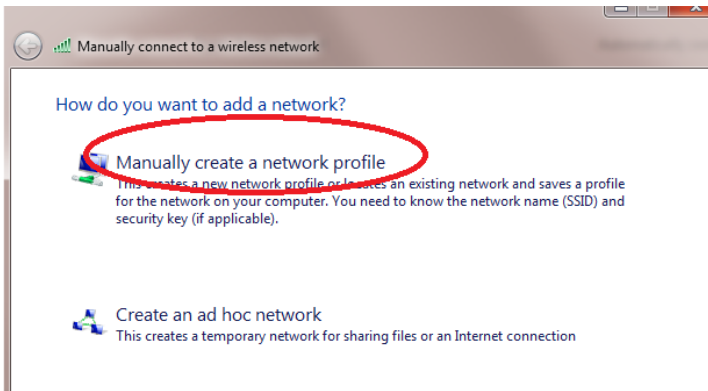
Click on Manage wireless network



Click Add



Click on Manually create a network profile

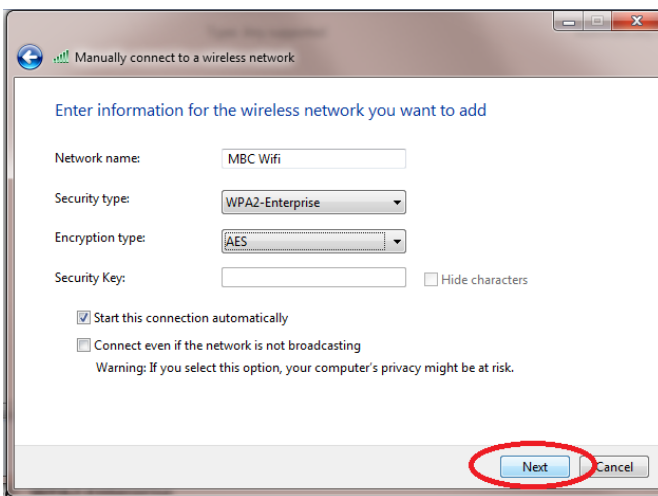


Inside Network name type: MBC Wifi

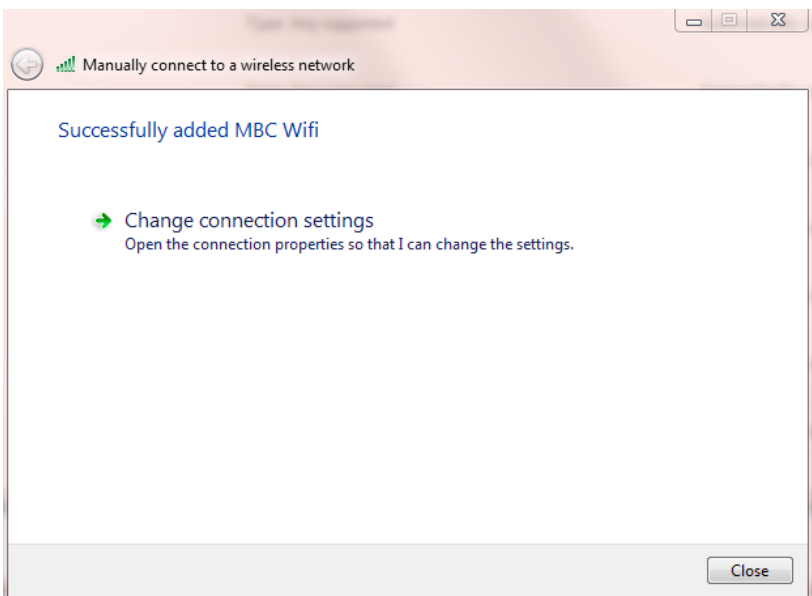
Security type: WPA2-Enterprise

Encryption type: AES

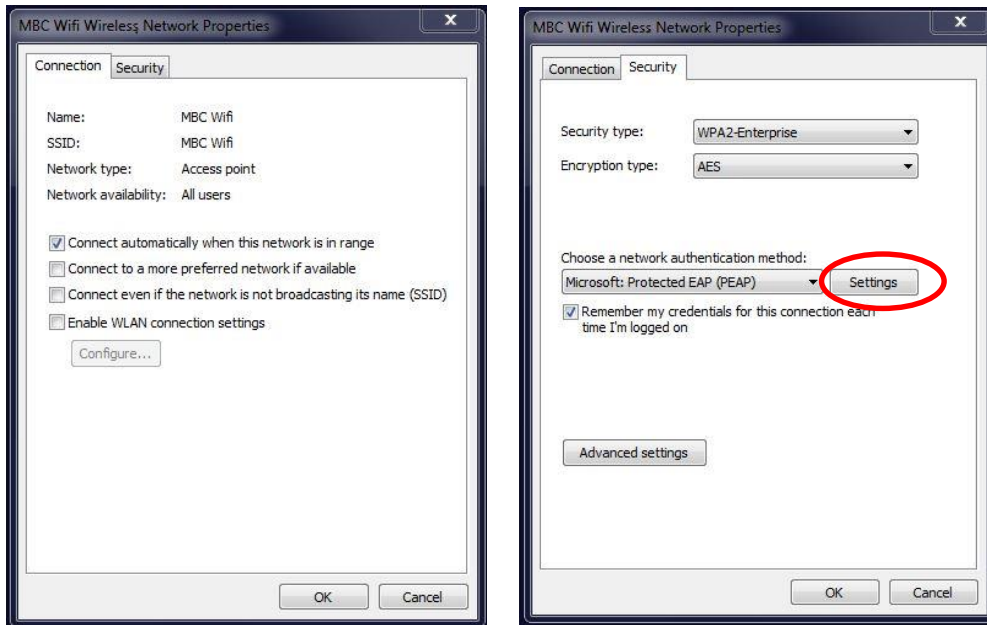
Check box for – Start this connection automatically



This will add MBC Wifi as an option on your computer. Click on Change Connection Settings.

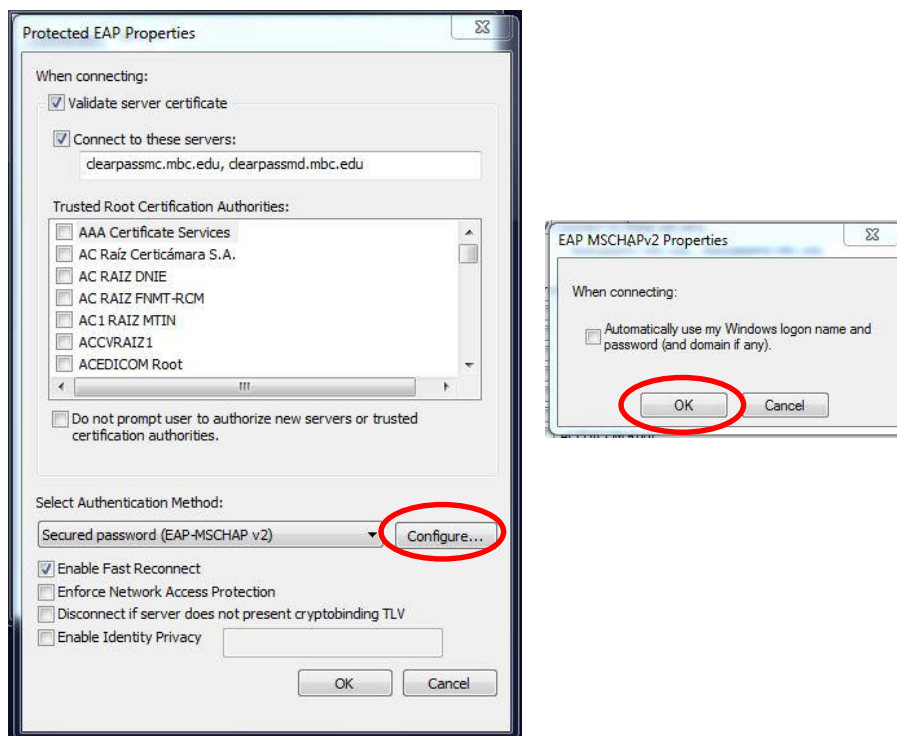


Go through the tabs and match your settings. Ensure the settings match the screens below for Connection and Security. Then click on Settings.

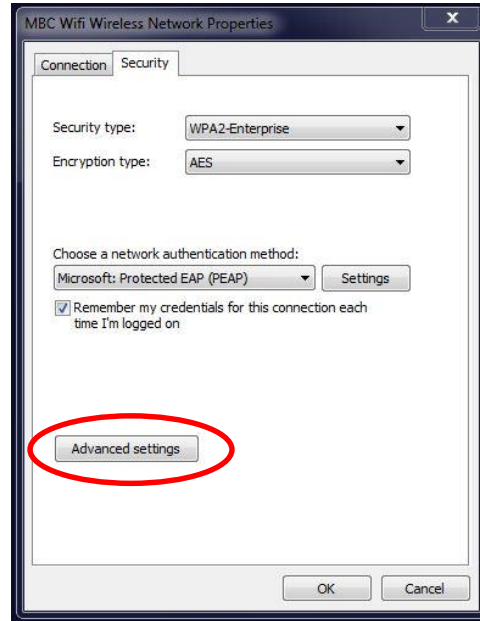


Ensure Connect to these servers is checked, and fill in the servers with:  
clearpassmc.mbc.edu, clearpassmd.mbc.edu

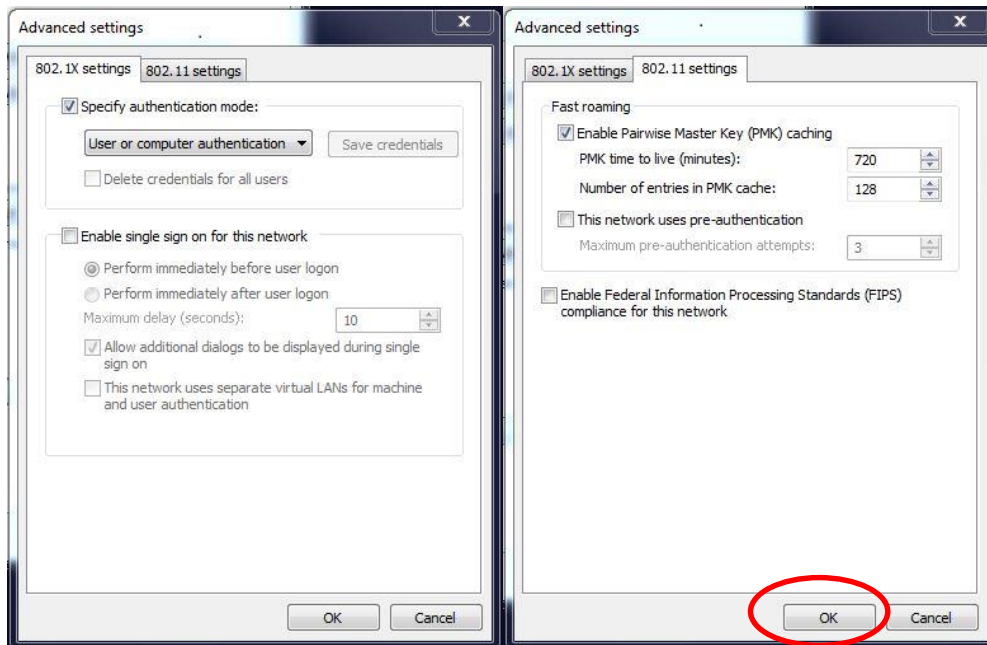
Click on Configure. Ensure Automatically use my Windows login name and password is Unchecked. Click on OK. Click on Ok again.



Click on Advanced Settings:



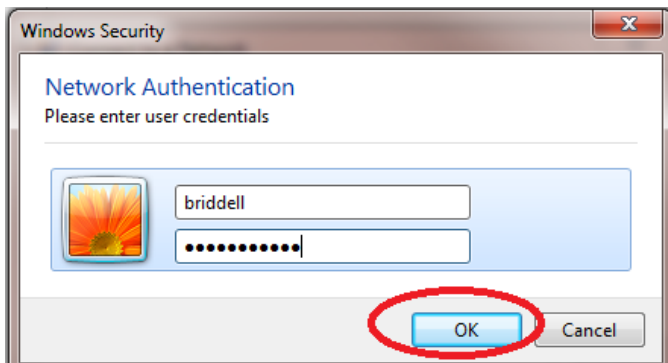
On the 802.1X Settings tab, click on Specify authentication mode. On the 802.11 settings tab, make sure Enable Pairwise Master Key is clicked. Click on OK. And click on OK again.



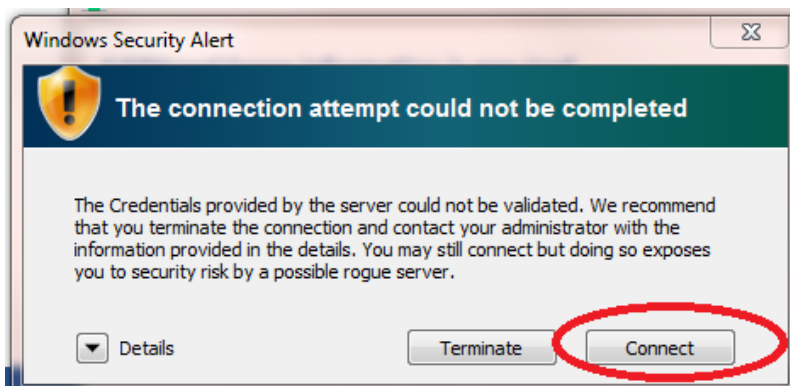
Click on Network Connection Icon in the task bar and MBC Wifi
