Jazmine: Have you been checking your suggestion boxes, and Shari have you received any suggestions?

Jazmine: After today, we're going to establish concrete committees instead of forming committees

Yik Yak Proposal

We are going to get into groups and we are going to come up with new ideas. We voted on altering the proposal to better fit our campus. The Yik Yak proposal committee/group will be on its own.

Current Proposal: we have asked administration to ban Yik Yak on the campus network. We are now going to work on revamping this proposal.

Ideas from Senate Board:

- We want to see the introduction of a Race-emphasis class in the core curriculum
- Want student representatives on the committee that will be formed after the Campus Climate Survey -- ideally want these students to be from EC/Senate Board/Senate
- Could change it from a ban of Yik Yak to asking the admin to thoroughly investigate when an altercation happens on Yik Yak
- Could have a day on campus dedicated to reducing racial tensions
- Do not want the network to be as overburdened as Mr. McQueen said it would be if Yik Yak does get banned.

Ideas from Madeleine, Aji, Deandra:

- Try and look into geofencing because we have minors on campus -- contacting Yik Yak Ideas from Juanaysa, Theresa, Zorina:
 - Also wanted to try geofencing
 - Want the school to update the network so that it doesn't glitch

Ideas from Ban Yik Yak Committee (Layla, Tevanah, Laura, Khabirah):

• Geofencing because there are PEGs on campus

Amber: I think it would be appropriate to approach this as an altered proposal. We don't have to go into rewriting the entire proposal.

Juanaysa: How would we go into geofencing? Yik Yak says that you can only contact them through law enforcement.

Amber: President Fox would look into this and work with law enforcement on their behalf

Tevanah: Are they going to work on the network?

Jazmine: Mr. McQueen said it's not going to happen in the next year.

Amber: That is not the top priority right now because they're in the process of changing the student information system.

The two common ideas are geofencing and asking administration to more thoroughly investigate matters. By majority show of hands, we are voting on altering the proposal to include both of these components.
